- Hospitalists admit and rounds afford afford a stigned to the Hospitalist Service (primarily adult, med/surg, telemetry patients) and consults on other services. As the MICU, CCU and OBS are closed units, the Hospitalist Physician is NOT responsible for these admissions.
- During an average shift, Physicians will round on an average of 14-16 patient with 1-2 admits per day.
- Common conditions managed are congestive heart failure, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, pneumonia, diabetes, stroke, acute coronary syndrome, and sepsis.
- The Hospitalists teams are not responsible for rapid response or codes.
- The successful candidate will be expected to take advantage of the many opportunities for teaching medical students and supervising and training internal medicine residents, based on experience.
