services for craniofacial deformities, brain tumors, epilepsy, congenital anomalies, vascular disorders, functional disorders and all other neurosurgical conditions afflicting children.

- Participation in pediatric only on-call coverage will include coverage of pediatric neurosurgical emergencies at the Level 1 Pediatric Trauma Center at John R. Oishei Children's Hospital.
- Active participation in resident education through supervision in the clinical setting and operating room, academic curriculum development and mentorship. Other activities include participation in medical student education, research and scholarship.

There are 185 inpatient beds, 64 NICU (largest in western New York), 20 PICU beds, 11 Hematology/Oncology Beds, 12 Epilepsy Monitoring beds, 15 Operating Rooms and an Emergency Department that includes 19 ER rooms, 5 kids express rooms and 4 trauma rooms. It is the only free standing children's hospital in New York State and an ACS verified Level 1 Pediatric Trauma Center with nearly all subspecialty representation.
