We are seeking an individual with expertise in teaching Biochemistry in our Medical, Dental, and MS in Biomedical Sciences programs. In addition to teaching, the successful candidate will contribute to educational scholarship, student mentoring, and committee service. Candidates should demonstrate a strong record of teaching excellence, potential for innovative educational scholarship, and a commitment to inclusive excellence.

Applications will be reviewed beginning November 15 and will continue on a rolling basis until the position is filled. The appointment will start no later than July 1, 2026.
